**Eligibility criteria:**

- Paper with a digital object identifier (DOI) prior to the submission deadline;
- The paper must be published between the before the 31<sup>st</sup> December 2015;
- Candidate must be a **SYIS member at the time of award submission** (those with a faculty position are excluded). Please email SYIS if you have a query regarding eligibility;
- The majority of the body of work described in the article **must have been carried out in a European lab** (first and/or last senior author being European based);
- The applicant **must be a first (or joint first)** author of the article.

**Evaluation:**

Submissions will undergo a number of evaluation criteria and metrics, which will be considered by the judging committee. These include, but are not limited to:

- Number of citations (the timeframe from which the paper was initially published will be taken into account);
- The breadth of the work undertaken by the applicant;
- The number of times the paper has been read, downloaded, appeared as a notable mention in other media;

**Applicants are required to send:**

- Copy of the article;
- Article Metrics (e.g. number of citations);
- Applicant's contribution to the article (writing, experiments performed, platform development, etc.);
- Applicant's CV to verify eligibility;
- Cover letter;
- Letter of support from the last senior author of the article.
